WATCH THE FRONT DOOR

Even the calmest pet may try to escape, as too many strangers can be overwhelming and stressful.

DOUBLE-CHECK PET ID'S

A collar and tags and/or microchip can be a lifesaver if your pet happens to escape or become lost.

THROW WRAPPERS AWAY

Aluminum foil or cellophane packaging can cause intestinal blockage and vomiting when ingested.
