

PET TRAVEL CHECKLIST

Traveling with a pet is easier and more fun when you remember these important items!



☐ COLLAR, ID TAGS & LEASH

To prevent your pet from getting lost, keep them on a leash when outside and make sure they have a collar with proper ID.



☐ CRATE OR SAFETY HARNESS

A crate or safety harness will keep your pet secure during the car ride and may reduce their anxiety.

☐ BLANKIE & TOY

Don't forget your pet's favorite blankie to help them sleep soundly, and bring toys to help them get out stress and excess energy.

☐ WATER, FOOD & TREATS

Water and your pet's regular food are essentials. Add some of your pet's favorite treats to your bag as well for road snacks.



☐ FOOD & WATER BOWLS

Don't forget bowls for eating and drinking. It's smart to place a bowl of water down for your pet at rest stops to ensure they're staying hydrated.

☐ LITTER BOX OR WASTE BAGS

Be a courteous guest wherever you stay by cleaning up after your pet! Make sure to bring enough fresh litter or waste bags to last the whole trip.

☐ GROOMING SUPPLIES

Adventures can sometimes be messy! It's a good idea to pack grooming supplies to keep your pet, and the place where you're staying, clean and comfortable.

☐ VACCINATION RECORDS

Have vaccination records on hand if you plan to board your pet or take them to a daycare.

☐ MEDICATIONS

Pack any daily medications your pet takes, as well as aspirin, in case of injuries, an antihistamine, in case of allergic reaction, and flea/tick preventive.



☐ PET FIRST-AID KIT

Help keep your pet safe wherever the road takes you with a pet first-aid kit, which contains things like gauze, tape, syringes, and forceps for removing splinters and ticks.

☐ VETERINARIAN CONTACT INFO

In the event of an emergency, it's good to leave your veterinary contact info with anyone who will be looking after your pet during your trip.

☐ RECENT PHOTO

Should you and your pet become separated, it's useful to have a recent photo of them. That way, people know exactly who to search for.
