

HOW HOT IS TOO HOT?

120°

Within 30 minutes, the car's interior can climb from 85° to 120°.

102°

On an 85° day, it only takes ten minutes for the inside of your car to reach 102°.

90°

Even if the temperature outside is only 70°, the inside of your car may be as much as 20 degrees hotter.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

1. Young, elderly, overweight, short-muzzled pets and pets with thick or dark-colored coats **are most at risk for overheating.**
2. **A vehicle may overheat** even with the windows left open an inch or two.
3. **It is prohibited by law** in many areas to leave pets unattended in a vehicle under unsafe conditions, including a hot day.
4. Shade moves with the sun and **provides little protection on a hot day.**
