Bad breath or messy eating



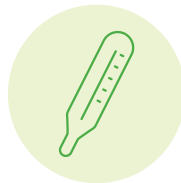
Vomiting



Changes in appearance of eyes, ears, fur, or skin



Changes in bowel movements (diarrhea, straining to defecate, bloody feces, or smaller BMs)



Fever which includes unusually warm nose, red eyes, lethargy, warm ears, or shivering
