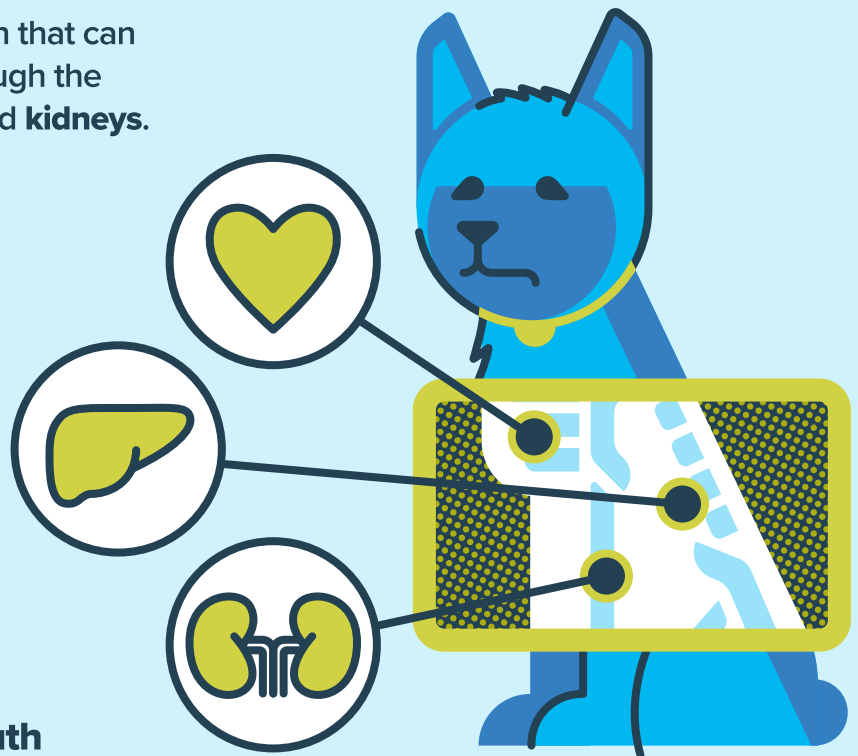

## signs of periodontal disease

Periodontal disease is an infection that can cause tooth loss and spread through the body affecting the **heart, liver, and kidneys**.

Contact your veterinarian if you notice these signs:

- **Bad breath**
- **Loose or broken teeth**
- **Inflamed gums**
- **Bleeding gums**
- **Excessive drooling**
- **Difficulty chewing**
- **Loss of appetite**
- **Sensitivity around the mouth**
