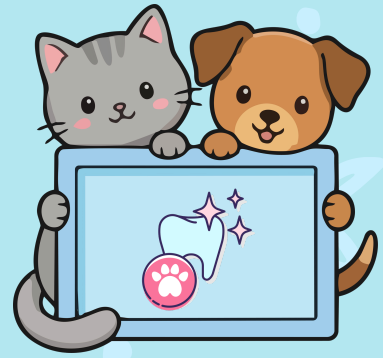


pet dental DOs and DON'TS
