

Pet Travel Checklist

Collar, Identification, Tag, and Leash

Essential to ensure your pets safety and to make identification easier if they get lost during the trip. Make sure these items are up-to-date.



Carrier or Safety Harness

Allows for safe travel, whether by car, train, or airplane.



Familiar Blanket and Toy

Help reduce stress and provide a sense of comfort in a new environment.



Food & Water Bowls

Ideally foldable or easy to carry.



Water, Food, & Treats

Bring enough food for the duration of the trip, as well as treats to reward your pet.



Litter Box or Waste Bags

Essential for complying with hygiene rules and local regulations.



Check that Your Accommodation Allows Pets

Check the conditions in advance to avoid any surprises.



Pet First Aid Kit

Useful in case of minor incidents (cuts, irritations, etc.)



Medications

If your pet is undergoing treatment, make sure you have a sufficient supply for the entire stay.



Recent Photo & Your Veterinarian's Contact Information

A recent photo is extremely useful if your pet is lost or if you need to contact your veterinarian quickly.



Insurance Documents & Medical Records

These are essential, especially the vaccination record, as they make it easier to access accommodations, medical care, and reimbursements, regardless of your destination.
